2006 South Central Regional Conference

January 27-28, 2006

Houston Hobby Airport Marriott

You are invited to attend the 2006 South Central Regional Conference. This is an annual conference for commanders throughout the region. This includes commanders from the following districts: Central Latin, Gulf Latin, Kansas, New Mexico, North Texas, Oklahoma, South Texas, and West Texas. This conference is a great time for training, fellowship, and spiritual renewal. Many commanders will also bring their wife and make this a mini-vacation.

It will be held January 27-28, 2006 at Houston Hobby Airport Marriott in Houston, Texas. Make plans now to attend the conference, and to bring your pastor and the other commanders from your outpost. You will enjoy the ministry, fellowship, and training that you receive, and you will return to your church charged up for ministry to the boys in your outpost and community.

Who should attend? Everyone! If you are involved in Royal Rangers at any level — local outpost or some staff position — the regional conference is for you. Everyone will find a variety of classes that should be interest for you, and that will help you in your ministry to boys. Classes will include LTA modules, classes by our speaker Robert T. Schlipp (Bibleman) and Deputy National Commander Mike Laliberty, and others. There will be a wide variety of classes for every commander. There is also a wide variety of classes that would be of interest to Missionettes leaders if they want to attend. Everyone is welcome.

Conference Schedule. Friday 10:00 a.m. Registration opens in hotel foyer (be sure not to wait until just before class time to register; avoid the long line by registering early); 1:00 – 5:00 Afternoon class sessions (see registration form for class list); 7:00 p.m. Evening service in the hotel ballroom (everyone welcome); Saturday 8:00 a.m. Registration opens; 8:00 – 9:15 General Session in hotel ballroom; 9:45 – 5:00 Class sessions (see registration form).

Friday. We have a variety of classes scheduled for Friday afternoon for those who want to attend. These classes start at 1:00. The classes for this conference are listed on the application form. The evening service will be at 7:00 p.m. Friday night at the hotel; this service will feature a time of praise and worship, and the ministry of children's evangelist Robert T. Schlipp. This service is open to everyone. Come expecting an outpouring of the Holy Spirit during this anointed service.

Special Guests. Our special guests for the conference include:

- Rev. Robert T. Schlipp, a children's evangelist who ministers across the country as Bibleman. Robert grew up in Royal Rangers. He earned his Gold Medal of Achievement and served a term as the assistant national FCF scout. He has a unique perspective on ministry to boys through the Royal Rangers ministry, and he will be sharing with us during the Friday evening service, Saturday morning general session, and he will be presenting two workshops on integrating God's word into object lessons.

- Mike Laliberty, deputy national commander and national training coordinator, will be presenting the NTC Staff Update on Friday afternoon and Saturday morning, and then will be presenting a two-hour workshop on the effective use of the Discovery and Adventure Rangers curricula materials.
- Fred Deaver, national FCF president emeritus, will be sharing with us on Saturday morning during the general session. He will also have some of his artwork available for purchase in the exhibit area throughout the conference, and we will auction off one of his paintings during the Saturday morning general session.

Hotel Information. For 2006, the conference will be held at the Houston Hobby Airport Marriott in SE Houston. This location is very convenient to Galveston Island, NASA, and many of the attractions of the Houston area. The Marriott Hotel has been very nicely renovated and it is ready to host our conference. They have given us a special room rate of \$70 per room (1-4 people), or \$80 if you would like a junior suite. Staying at the host hotel will not only be convenient for you, but it helps the region offset the costs of holding the conference at this hotel. If you want to reserve your room by phone, call the Marriott at 800-228-9290 and mention the conference code "ROV" to get this special room rate. If you prefer, you can make your reservation on the Marriott web site (www.marriott.com/HOUHH) and in the group code field enter "ROVROVA." This rate will be honored before and after the conference if you want to come early and/or stay after the conference for shopping or sight seeing. This rate is only guaranteed until January 20, so make your reservation early!

Registration. The registration fee for the conference is \$35 if you register online or \$40 if you register through the mail by the deadline. Registration at the conference will be \$45. Pre-registration fees may be paid by check or money order, or by credit card (credit card only if you register on the web). Two classes will require additional registration because of additional materials that must be purchased by the region for each attendee: the first aid course will cost an additional \$20, and the NTC Staff Update will cost an additional \$10.

Boys who have earned their Gold Medal of Achievement and who are willing to help out at the conference as a GMA Staff Aid will have their registration fee waived. Boys must apply to Tony Garcia (tony@copydocs.net) in order to be considered a Staff Aid and to have their registration fee waived.

Ladies Activities: If your wife is not involved in the Royal Rangers ministry, we encourage you to bring her along anyway. Everyone is welcome for the Friday evening service, and Saturday morning there will be a time for our wives to get acquainted and to have a devotion presented by Anay Schlipp, wife of our speaker who served as Biblewoman for at least one season with her husband. Following this, bus transportation will be available to Galveston Island for shopping on the historic Strand, or sightseeing on the island.

Class Schedule. On the class schedule is a wide variety of classes – some are LTA modules, while others are sessions for any commander. Certificates of Completion will be issued for each LTA module completed. All sessions are open to any leader with the exception of the IT Seminar (your district commander must approve your attendance) and the NTC Staff Update (you must have previously attended NTC Staff School or National Academy). There are additional charges for the First Aid/CPR class and the NTC Staff Update classes because of the additional materials that must be purchased for attendees.

Missionettes leaders would find the following classes helpful in their ministry to girls: Impressive Awards Ceremonies, Presentation Skills, Keep Records Get Refunds!, Preventing Child and Substance Abuse, Ranger Kids Activities, Integrating the Word into Object Lessons, and Story of the Bible.
