There are five national training events scheduled for our region during the last half of this year. Each of these training opportunities will provide you and the other leaders in your outpost with outstanding training that will help you minister to the boys in your outpost more effectively. Registrations are still being accepted for all of these training opportunities. National Training Camp (NTC). NTC is designed to give leaders professional training in camping and leadership, plus the opportunity of outstanding fellowship with other leaders and adventure in the outdoors. NTC is a pre-requisite for all other national training events except Ranger Kids Training Conference (RKTC) and World Class Outpost Seminar (WCO). The NTC in our region this year will be held at Lakeview Camp, Maypearl, TX, on September 25-28, 2008.

Ranger Kids Training Conference (RKTC). RKTC is designed to give leaders training in various techniques and methods of leadership.

Leaders will also receive training in various aspects of the Ranger Kids ministries. We have two RKTCS scheduled in our region over the next few months. The first will be held in Alvin, TX from October 31 to November 2. The second will be held on two consecutive Saturdays at Chandler, OK. This one will be held on November 8 and November 15. You must attend both Saturdays to complete the camp.

World Class Outpost Seminar (WCO). The WCO seminar is designed to expose the outpost leadership team to a successful set of practices, methods, strategies, and tools that will enable them to develop into a "World Class Outpost." The outpost leaders are encouraged to attend and complete this event together. We have two WCOs scheduled in our region, both in the month of August. North Texas will host one in Carrollton, TX on August 1-2, and Oklahoma will host one in Broken Arrow on August 15-16.

In March of 2007 our new national commander asked the field for input concerning the Royal Rangers ministry. Many of you spoke, and National Commander Doug Marsh and his team listened. Throughout 2007 comments flooded the national office through the QLC (question, learn, change) process. Based on that feedback from you and others involved in the Royal Rangers ministry, the national Royal Rangers leadership team released a series of vision articles in March 2008 that provide a roadmap of where the Royal Rangers ministry will head over the next 3-5 years.
