2005 Plainsmen Territorial Rendezvous

The dates for the 2005 Plainsmen Territorial Rendezvous are approaching rapidly. FCF members from across the Territory will be heading to the NRA Whittington Center near Raton, New Mexico for our biennial rendezvous July 14-16. The rendezvous this year should be a special one for many reasons: new location (NRA Whittington Center); anointed speaker (Sonny Green, national FCF vice-president emeritus) and times of spiritual renewal; national and territorial scout selection; outstanding competitions and prizes in shooting, hawk and knife throwing, flint and steel fire starting, cooking, stump preaching, outfits, and adventure trail; and the chance to renew old acquaintances and meet new friends. FCF members are encouraged to camp in the rendezvous site at the Whittington Center. If your family is coming with you, there are facilities for you to camp with your family at a different part of the Whittington Center. There are also hotels in the area if your family would prefer a more modern camping experience while you enjoy the rendezvous. More information on these alternatives can be obtained from John "Pepperspark" Permenter, our territorial FCF representative.

Camp set-up will begin July 13, with activities starting at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 14th. All activities will end by 5:00 p.m. on the 16th, though you can stay until the 17th before you break camp and head for home. Registration will be open July 13-16.

Registrations WILL be accepted at the rendezvous if you don't happen to get registered by the pre-registration deadline.
