## National FCF Rendezvous

The 2008 National FCF Rendezvous will start in just over a week. If you have already made plans to attend, great! I look forward to seeing you there. If not, it's not too late to attend. Registration can still be done at the door. Make sure, if you are registering at the camp, that adults have their pastor's signature and that boys have the Knife and Hawk form signed by a parent. This likely will be the only national FCF rendezvous that your boys will be able to attend as Young Bucks. Because of the recently announced shift in dates for the next National Camporama (2012 to coincide with our 50th anniversary of the Royal Rangers ministry) we won't have another national FCF rendezvous until 2014.

**National Training Camp (NTC).** NTC is designed to give leaders professional training in camping and leadership, plus the opportunity of outstanding fellowship with other leaders and adventure in the outdoors. NTC is a pre-requisite for all other national training events except Ranger Kids Training Conference (RKTC) and World Class Outpost Seminar (WCO). The NTC in our region this year will be held at Lakeview Camp, Maypearl, TX, on September 25-28, 2008. This deadline to receive a discount on your registration is August 28.

**Ranger Kids Training Conference (RKTC).** RKTC is designed to give leaders training in various techniques and methods of leadership.

Coordinator Leaders will also receive training in various aspects of the Ranger Kids ministries. We have two RKTCs scheduled in our region over the next few months. The first will be held in Alvin, TX from October 31 to November 2. The second will be held on two consecutive Saturdays at Chandler, OK. This one will be held on November 8 and November 15. You must attend both Saturdays to complete the camp. If you are planning on attending either of these RKTCs, send in your application form. The national office, and the staff of the camps, needs to know that there is interest in these camps!

**World Class Outpost Seminar (WCO).** The WCO seminar is designed to expose the outpost leadership team to a successful set of practices, methods, strategies, and tools that will enable them to develop into a "World Class Outpost." The outpost leaders are encouraged to attend and complete this event together. We have two WCOs scheduled in our region, both in the month of August. North Texas will host one in Carrollton, TX on August 1-2, and Oklahoma will host one in Broken Arrow on August 15-16. Applications are still being accepted for both of these conferences. The one in Carrollton has more than the minimum number of registrations needed, so it definitely will be held. The one in Broken Arrow still needs more people to register, so send your registration forms in today if you are planning on attending.
